<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Demonstrates understanding when listening 	<p>Listening Game: Put the Cloth on -----. Give each child a small cloth and ask them to put it on different body part.</p>	<p>This game can be played at home with a washcloth. The goal of the game is for your child to follow the direction correctly only being asked once.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Begins to demonstrate an understanding of basic spatial directions through songs, finger plays and games 	<p>Using House cutouts and people counters, the children will practice the use of positional words such as in, out, next to, in between, on top, above, and below.</p>	<p>Positional words can be practiced at home by asking your child to put a toy under the table, next to the chair, behind the pillow.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Coordinates perceptual information and motor actions to participate in play and activities (e.g., singing songs with hand motions or rolling/catching ball ● Develops positive relationships with peers ● Demonstrates understanding when listening 	<p>Name Game: Roll a small ball to a friend and say their name</p>	<p>You can play this game at home with your family. You could also work on rolling the ball slowly or quickly to each other. This game requires you child exercise some self-control because the ball is to be rolled and not thrown.</p>
